#### WHAT IS DISABILITY?

impairment + environment

#### 1 in 6 people have a disability

#### do a walkthrough & pay attention

"Where is the wheelchair-accessible entrance?"

"Is handicapped parking available?"

"Are there steps into presentation rooms?"

#### do a walkthrough & pay attention

"Where is an accessible bathroom?"

"Do your elevators lock after office hours?"

#### MAPS

label any steps (even just one)

label all event rooms

label elevators & accessible entrances

for all venues!

**bonus:** directions to/from recommended hotels, with links to accessible transit options

space out seating

signs everywhere

quiet area

tape out walkways



check your website

talk to your speakers



#### Color Communication Cards

These cards allow you to express your communication preferences to others quickly and non-verbally.

"Come talk to me!" — Display green cards if you're up for chatting!

"Do I know you?" - Display yellow cards if you just want to talk with friends.

"Not right now." — Display red cards if you wish to be left alone.
